Each spring, we provide every WWA teacher with \$350 to use as they see fit for their classrooms. In the past these funds have been used for prizes and incentives, classroom supplies, continuing education for our teachers, and more. Additionally, we support WWA with an annual large purchase for the school. Past purchases have included a buddy bench for the new playground, a gaga ball pit, and two awnings for the Field of Dreams project. We provide funds for kindergarten and eight grade graduations, middle school rewards, and teacher conference meals. We also provide funds for other activities and expenses throughout the year.
